**IDBF WORLD DRAGON BOAT CHAMPIONSHIPS – 18th to 22nd October 2017**

The 13th World Dragon Boat Racing Championships (Kunming, China), in addition to the championships, will also involve the IDBF Congress, Council Meeting.

Racing for the 13th World Dragon Boat Racing Championships (Kunming, China) will take place from October 18th – 22nd inclusive, with the Opening Ceremony on Tuesday October 17th, 2017. Competing Teams for the WDBRC are expected to arrive in Kunming, China between Saturday October 14th and Monday October 16th, 2017.

Provisional Entries or intentions to compete in the 13th WDBRC, have been received from 23 IDBF Members, including: Australia; Canada; China; China Hong Kong; China Macau; Chinese Taipei; Cyprus; Germany; Great Britain; Guam; India; Indonesia; Iran; Italy; Myanmar; New Zealand; Puerto Rico; Russia; Singapore; Sweden; Thailand; Ukraine and United States of America.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Please take careful note of the Entry Conditions which were noted in Bulletin 1 and further details on mixed crews is added below. Please note that all countries must be current paid members of IDBF. If you have not paid the membership fee will be invoiced with the named entries.

### **MIXED CREW REQUIREMENTS**

**Standard Boat Crews** – The crew must consist of a minimum of 8 and maximum of 10 paddlers of either gender. Drummers and Helms can be of either gender.

This means that for a full crew of 20 paddlers 10 must be males and 10 females. For 18 paddlers then you can use 8 women and 10 men or 9 women and 9 men or 10 women and 8 men.

**Small Boat Crews** – The crew must consist of a minimum of 4 and maximum of 6 of either gender. Drummers and Helms can be of either gender.

### **STANDARD and SMALL BOATS**

If a Country wishes to enter a standard and small boat in the same competition class, the competitors in the standard boat must be completely different to those in the small boat, So the 26 competitors (including reserves) in the standard boat must be completely different to the 14 competitors (including reserves) in the small boat.

### **MIXED TEAMS – STANDARD AND SMALL BOAT COMBINATIONS**

Standard and small boat teams in the same competition class must combine to form standard boat mixed crews. The following table shows the way in which standard and small boats combine into standard boat mixed crews, where X is the entry.

**ACCOMMODATION**

**AIRPORT WELCOMING SERVICE**

Teams need to inform the Organising Committee of arrival details, they will then be greeted upon arrival and directed to their bus/van that will transport your team to your accommodations in Kunming.

Once the luggage is found, the 2017 WDBRC Organizing Committee will arrange to have the luggage brought to hotel of Kunming and returned to its owner.

**NATIONAL FLAGS**

Each Team taking part in the 2017 IDBF 13th World Dragon Boat Racing Championships is asked to bring with them two (2) Official Representative Flags for their country or territory, of a size approximately 1m x 0.5m.

One flag will be utilized at the Opening Ceremony for the Parade of Athletes, and the other will be utilized for Medal Ceremonies. Flags must be delivered to the Registration Centre at the time of accreditation.

**ANTI DOPING**

Tests will be conducted during the Championships. Therapeutic Use Exceptions (TUE) forms are available on the Registration Site

**ANTI DOPING COMPETITOR'S RIGHTS**

- Be notified of selection for doping control
- Be informed of the consequences of refusing to provide a sample
- Have the doping control procedures explained
- Be provided with a selection of sealed equipment from which to choose
- Be observed when providing sample by someone of the same gender
- Receive copies of all signed documentation

**ANTI DOPING COMPETITOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Know the IDBF and your IDBF Member's anti-doping regulations
- Carry photo ID to present to the Doping Control Officer (DCO)
- Inform your doctor or pharmacist that you are a competitor who may be subject to doping control
- Consult your IDBF Member in advance if you are medically required to take any medication on the prohibited list – before being permitted to take such substances, you will need to apply for medical exemption
- Keep a list of all medications, vitamins or supplements you are taking and declare them on the doping control form
- Be careful with unlicensed products such as nutritional supplements or herbal products as these may contain prohibited substances
- From notification through to completion of sample collection, stay in full view of the DCO or chaperone, whether at a competition, training venue or your home
- Re-hydrate with sealed non-alcoholic, caffeine- free beverage before the test
- Be prepared to begin sample collection procedures as soon as possible after notification
